* Students may be counted only once even though they may have met more than one economically disadvantaged criterion and/or been enrolled in more than one CTE course/program in the 2014–15 year. All economically disadvantaged students reported above must have completed at least 20 hours of instruction in a CTE course that is at least 20 hours or more in duration.

** Other category includes adults who have an income level below the poverty level as defined by the 2014–15 Income Eligibility Guidelines for Free and Reduced-Price Meals. Though independent third-party verified data is preferred, an eligible recipient may also report those adults who have been identified by self-declaration as meeting one of the economically disadvantaged criteria. 2. Programs must maintain the roster of names for each economically disadvantaged criterion to verify that the adults reported meet the required criteria. The numbers reported must be auditable.
